

## AQA (GCSE Notes)

### Chapter 2: Ratio, Proportion, and Rates of Change

**Q1. A car travels 180 miles in 4 hours. How long would it take the same car to travel 315 miles at the same speed?**

**Answer:** 7 hours

**Solution:**

Speed = Distance  $\div$  Time

Speed =  $180 \div 4 = 45$  mph

Time = Distance  $\div$  Speed =  $315 \div 45 = 7$  hours

**Q2. A worker is paid £13.50 per hour. How much does she earn for working 37.5 hours?**

**Answer:** £506.25

**Solution:**

Earnings = Hourly Rate  $\times$  Hours Worked

Earnings =  $13.50 \times 37.5 = £506.25$

**Q3. A recipe requires 200 g of flour for 8 cookies. How much flour is needed for 30 cookies?**

**Answer:** 750 g

**Solution:**

Flour per cookie =  $200 \div 8 = 25$  g

Flour for 30 cookies =  $25 \times 30 = 750$  g

**Q4. A block of metal has a mass of 540 g and a volume of 90 cm<sup>3</sup>. Calculate its density.**

**Answer:** 6 g/cm<sup>3</sup>

**Solution:**

Density = Mass  $\div$  Volume

Density =  $540 \div 90 = 6$  g/cm<sup>3</sup>

**Q5. Water is leaking from a tank at a constant rate. After 3 hours, 7.5 litres have leaked. How much would have leaked after 8 hours?**

**Answer:** 20 litres

**Solution:**

Leak rate =  $7.5 \div 3 = 2.5$  litres/hour

Leak in 8 hours =  $2.5 \times 8 = 20$  litres

**Q6. The mass of 6 identical balls is 2.4 kg. What is the mass of 10 such balls?**

**Answer:** 4 kg

**Solution:**

Mass of one ball =  $2.4 \div 6 = 0.4$  kg

Mass of 10 balls =  $0.4 \times 10 = 4$  kg



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**Q7. A person runs 800 m in 2 minutes. Find their average speed in metres per second.**

**Answer:** 6.67 m/s

**Solution:**

Time in seconds =  $2 \times 60 = 120$  seconds

Speed = Distance  $\div$  Time =  $800 \div 120 = 6.67$  m/s

**Q8. A machine produces 45 units in 3 hours. How many units can it produce in 8 hours?**

**Answer:** 120 units

**Solution:**

Units per hour =  $45 \div 3 = 15$

Units in 8 hours =  $15 \times 8 = 120$  units

**Q9. A car accelerates from 0 to 60 mph in 8 seconds. Find the average acceleration.**

**Answer:** 7.5 mph/s

**Solution:**

Acceleration = Change in speed  $\div$  Time

Acceleration =  $(60 - 0) \div 8 = 60 \div 8 = 7.5$  mph/s

**Q10. A student earns £270 for working 18 hours. What is their hourly rate of pay?**

**Answer:** £15 per hour

**Solution:**

Hourly rate = Total pay  $\div$  Hours

Hourly rate =  $270 \div 18 = £15$ /hour

**Q11. Convert 1.75 hours into minutes.**

**Answer:** 105 minutes

**Solution:**

1 hour = 60 minutes

$1.75 \times 60 = 105$  minutes

**Q12. A cyclist travels 40 km in 2 hours and 30 minutes. Calculate the speed in km/h.**

**Answer:** 16 km/h

**Solution:**

2 hours 30 minutes = 2.5 hours

Speed = Distance  $\div$  Time =  $40 \div 2.5 = 16$  km/h

**Q13. A builder mixes cement in the ratio 5:2:1 of sand, gravel, and cement. If he uses 84 kg of gravel, how much sand does he need?**

**Answer:** 210 kg

**Solution:**

Total parts =  $5 + 2 + 1 = 8$

Gravel part = 2



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$$1 \text{ part} = 84 \div 2 = 42$$

$$\text{Sand part} = 5 \times 42 = 210 \text{ kg}$$

**Q14. A bottle contains 1.5 litres of juice. How many millilitres is this?**

**Answer:** 1500 ml

**Solution:**

$$1 \text{ litre} = 1000 \text{ ml}$$

$$1.5 \times 1000 = 1500 \text{ ml}$$

**Q15. The pressure on a surface is  $60 \text{ N/m}^2$  and the force is 1200 N. Find the area.**

**Answer:**  $20 \text{ m}^2$

**Solution:**

$$\text{Pressure} = \text{Force} \div \text{Area}$$

$$\text{Area} = \text{Force} \div \text{Pressure} = 1200 \div 60 = 20 \text{ m}^2$$

**Q16. The density of a liquid is  $1.2 \text{ g/cm}^3$ . What is the mass of  $500 \text{ cm}^3$  of this liquid?**

**Answer:** 600 g

**Solution:**

$$\text{Mass} = \text{Density} \times \text{Volume}$$

$$\text{Mass} = 1.2 \times 500 = 600 \text{ g}$$

**Q17. A bus travels 120 miles in 2.5 hours. What is its average speed?**

**Answer:** 48 mph

**Solution:**

$$\text{Speed} = \text{Distance} \div \text{Time}$$

$$\text{Speed} = 120 \div 2.5 = 48 \text{ mph}$$

**Q18. Convert  $2.4 \text{ km}^2$  to  $\text{m}^2$ .**

**Answer:** 2,400,000  $\text{m}^2$

**Solution:**

$$1 \text{ km}^2 = 1,000,000 \text{ m}^2$$

$$2.4 \times 1,000,000 = 2,400,000 \text{ m}^2$$

**Q19. A person walks 6 km at 4 km/h. How long does the journey take?**

**Answer:** 1.5 hours

**Solution:**

$$\text{Time} = \text{Distance} \div \text{Speed}$$

$$\text{Time} = 6 \div 4 = 1.5 \text{ hours}$$

**Q20. A job takes 6 men 10 days. How many days will it take 4 men, working at the same rate?**

**Answer:** 15 days

**Solution:**



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Total work =  $6 \times 10 = 60$  man-days

Time for 4 men =  $60 \div 4 = 15$  days

**Q21. A car travels 90 km at an average speed of 60 km/h. How long does the journey take in minutes?**

**Answer:** 90 minutes

**Solution:**

Time = Distance  $\div$  Speed

Time =  $90 \div 60 = 1.5$  hours

Time in minutes =  $1.5 \times 60 = 90$  minutes

**Q22. Convert 0.85 m<sup>3</sup> into litres.**

**Answer:** 850 litres

**Solution:**

1 m<sup>3</sup> = 1000 litres

$0.85 \times 1000 = 850$  litres

**Q23. A mixture contains water and alcohol in the ratio 3:2. If the total volume is 750 mL, how much is alcohol?**

**Answer:** 300 mL

**Solution:**

Total parts =  $3 + 2 = 5$

Alcohol part = 2

Volume of alcohol =  $(2 \div 5) \times 750 = 300$  mL

**Q24. The area of a rectangle is 48 cm<sup>2</sup>. If the length is 6 cm, what is the width?**

**Answer:** 8 cm

**Solution:**

Area = Length  $\times$  Width

Width = Area  $\div$  Length =  $48 \div 6 = 8$  cm

**Q25. A cylinder has a height of 10 cm and volume of 942 cm<sup>3</sup>. Find the radius of the base (use  $\pi = 3.14$ ).**

**Answer:** 5.48 cm

**Solution:**

Volume =  $\pi r^2 h$

$942 = 3.14 \times r^2 \times 10$

$942 \div 3.14 = r^2 \times 10$

$300 = r^2 \times 10$

$r^2 = 300 \div 10 = 30$

$r = \sqrt{30} \approx 5.48$  cm



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**Q26. A person earns £15 per hour for the first 40 hours and £22.50 for any extra hours. How much do they earn in a week if they work 48 hours?**

**Answer:** £870

**Solution:**

$$\text{Basic pay} = 40 \times 15 = \text{£}600$$

$$\text{Overtime hours} = 48 - 40 = 8$$

$$\text{Overtime pay} = 8 \times 22.50 = \text{£}180$$

$$\text{Total pay} = 600 + 180 = \text{£}780$$

**Q27. The density of a substance is 8.5 g/cm<sup>3</sup>. What volume is occupied by 255 g of the substance?**

**Answer:** 30 cm<sup>3</sup>

**Solution:**

$$\text{Volume} = \text{Mass} \div \text{Density}$$

$$\text{Volume} = 255 \div 8.5 = 30 \text{ cm}^3$$

**Q28. A machine produces 480 units in 6 hours. How many units does it produce per minute?**

**Answer:** 1.33 units per minute

**Solution:**

$$\text{Total minutes} = 6 \times 60 = 360$$

$$\text{Units per minute} = 480 \div 360 = 1.33 \text{ units}$$

**Q29. A pipe fills a tank in 3 hours. Another pipe can fill the same tank in 5 hours. How long will it take to fill the tank if both pipes work together?**

**Answer:** 1.875 hours

**Solution:**

$$\text{Combined rate} = 1/3 + 1/5$$

$$\text{LCM of 3 and 5} = 15$$

$$= (5 + 3)/15 = 8/15$$

$$\text{Time} = 15 \div 8 = 1.875 \text{ hours}$$

**Q30. A car travels 180 km in 2.25 hours. Calculate its average speed.**

**Answer:** 80 km/h

**Solution:**

$$\text{Speed} = \text{Distance} \div \text{Time}$$

$$\text{Speed} = 180 \div 2.25 = 80 \text{ km/h}$$

**Q31. A cube has a volume of 125 cm<sup>3</sup>. What is the length of one side?**

**Answer:** 5 cm

**Solution:**

$$\text{Volume of cube} = \text{side}^3$$

$$\text{side} = \sqrt[3]{125} = 5 \text{ cm}$$



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**Q32. A shop reduces the price of an item by 20%. The original price was £75. What is the new price?**

**Answer:** £60

**Solution:**

$$\text{Reduction} = 20\% \text{ of } 75 = (20 \div 100) \times 75 = 15$$

$$\text{New price} = 75 - 15 = \text{£}60$$

**Q33. A train travels 225 miles in 3 hours and 45 minutes. What is its average speed in mph?**

**Answer:** 60 mph

**Solution:**

$$3 \text{ hours } 45 \text{ minutes} = 3.75 \text{ hours}$$

$$\text{Speed} = \text{Distance} \div \text{Time} = 225 \div 3.75 = 60 \text{ mph}$$

**Q34. If 6 pencils cost £2.70, what is the cost of 14 pencils?**

**Answer:** £6.30

**Solution:**

$$\text{Cost per pencil} = 2.70 \div 6 = \text{£}0.45$$

$$\text{Cost of 14 pencils} = 0.45 \times 14 = \text{£}6.30$$

**Q35. A metal rod weighs 2.4 kg and is 120 cm long. What is the weight per metre?**

**Answer:** 2 kg/m

**Solution:**

$$\text{Length in metres} = 120 \div 100 = 1.2 \text{ m}$$

$$\text{Weight per metre} = 2.4 \div 1.2 = 2 \text{ kg/m}$$

**Q36. A container holds 2.5 litres of paint. How many containers are needed to paint 45 m<sup>2</sup> if 1 litre covers 6 m<sup>2</sup>?**

**Answer:** 3 containers

**Solution:**

$$\text{Total paint needed} = 45 \div 6 = 7.5 \text{ litres}$$

$$\text{Containers needed} = 7.5 \div 2.5 = 3$$

**Q37. A person runs a marathon of 42.2 km in 3 hours and 20 minutes. What is their average speed?**

**Answer:** 12.66 km/h

**Solution:**

$$3 \text{ hours } 20 \text{ minutes} = 3.33 \text{ hours}$$

$$\text{Speed} = 42.2 \div 3.33 \approx 12.66 \text{ km/h}$$

**Q38. A garden path is 1.2 m wide and 8 m long. What is its area in square centimetres?**

**Answer:** 96000 cm<sup>2</sup>

**Solution:**

$$\text{Area in m}^2 = 1.2 \times 8 = 9.6 \text{ m}^2$$



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$$1 \text{ m}^2 = 10000 \text{ cm}^2$$

$$\text{Area} = 9.6 \times 10000 = 96000 \text{ cm}^2$$

**Q39. A car uses 6 litres of fuel to travel 90 km. How much fuel is needed to travel 150 km?**

**Answer:** 10 litres

**Solution:**

$$\text{Fuel per km} = 6 \div 90 = 0.0667 \text{ litres/km}$$

$$\text{Fuel for 150 km} = 0.0667 \times 150 = 10 \text{ litres}$$

**Q40. A recipe that serves 4 people uses 300 g of flour. How much flour is needed to serve 10 people?**

**Answer:** 750 g

**Solution:**

$$\text{Flour per person} = 300 \div 4 = 75 \text{ g}$$

$$\text{Flour for 10 people} = 75 \times 10 = 750 \text{ g}$$

**Q41. A box of cereal weighs 750 g. Convert this to kilograms.**

**Answer:** 0.75 kg

**Solution:**

$$1 \text{ kilogram} = 1000 \text{ grams}$$

$$\text{Weight in kg} = 750 \div 1000 = 0.75 \text{ kg}$$

**Q42. The exchange rate is £1 = €1.18. How many euros would you get for £250?**

**Answer:** €295

**Solution:**

$$\text{Euros} = \text{Pounds} \times \text{Exchange rate}$$

$$\text{Euros} = 250 \times 1.18 = €295$$

**Q43. The population of a town increases by 3% per year. If the current population is 12,000, what will it be next year?**

**Answer:** 12,360

**Solution:**

$$\text{Increase} = 3\% \text{ of } 12000 = (3 \div 100) \times 12000 = 360$$

$$\text{Next year's population} = 12000 + 360 = 12,360$$

**Q44. A factory produces 240 units in 8 hours. How many units are produced per hour?**

**Answer:** 30 units/hour

**Solution:**

$$\text{Units per hour} = 240 \div 8 = 30 \text{ units/hour}$$

**Q45. A bag of sugar weighs 1.5 kg. How many 250 g jars can be filled from one bag?**

**Answer:** 6 jars

**Solution:**



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Convert kg to g:  $1.5 \text{ kg} = 1500 \text{ g}$

Number of jars =  $1500 \div 250 = 6$  jars

**Q46. A boat travels 84 miles downstream in 4 hours. What is the speed of the boat?**

**Answer:** 21 mph

**Solution:**

Speed = Distance  $\div$  Time

Speed =  $84 \div 4 = 21$  mph

**Q47. The ratio of boys to girls in a class is 5:4. If there are 36 students in total, how many girls are there?**

**Answer:** 16 girls

**Solution:**

Total parts =  $5 + 4 = 9$

Girls part = 4

Girls =  $(4 \div 9) \times 36 = 16$

**Q48. A tank has a volume of  $0.75 \text{ m}^3$ . Convert this to litres.**

**Answer:** 750 litres

**Solution:**

$1 \text{ m}^3 = 1000$  litres

Litres =  $0.75 \times 1000 = 750$  litres

**Q49. A person cycles at 15 km/h for 2.5 hours. How far do they travel?**

**Answer:** 37.5 km

**Solution:**

Distance = Speed  $\times$  Time

Distance =  $15 \times 2.5 = 37.5$  km

**Q50. A rectangular room is 5 m by 4.5 m. What is the area in square centimetres?**

**Answer:** 225,000  $\text{cm}^2$

**Solution:**

Area in  $\text{m}^2 = 5 \times 4.5 = 22.5 \text{ m}^2$

$1 \text{ m}^2 = 10,000 \text{ cm}^2$

Area in  $\text{cm}^2 = 22.5 \times 10000 = 225,000 \text{ cm}^2$

**Q51. A tank holds 180 litres of water. It is emptied over 3 hours at a constant rate. How many litres of water are released per minute?**

**Answer:** 1 litre per minute

**Solution:**

Total time = 3 hours =  $3 \times 60 = 180$  minutes

Rate = Total volume  $\div$  Time

Rate =  $180 \text{ litres} \div 180 \text{ minutes} = 1$  litre per minute



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**Q52. A cyclist covers 36 km in 1 hour 20 minutes. What is their average speed in km/h?**

**Answer:** 27 km/h

**Solution:**

$$1 \text{ hour } 20 \text{ minutes} = 1 + 20/60 = 1.333... \text{ hours}$$

$$\text{Speed} = \text{Distance} \div \text{Time}$$

$$\text{Speed} = 36 \text{ km} \div 1.333... \text{ h} = 27 \text{ km/h}$$

**Q53. A car travels 150 miles using 12 gallons of fuel. What is the car's fuel consumption in miles per gallon?**

**Answer:** 12.5 miles per gallon

**Solution:**

$$\text{Fuel consumption} = \text{Distance} \div \text{Fuel used}$$

$$\text{Fuel consumption} = 150 \text{ miles} \div 12 \text{ gallons} = 12.5 \text{ miles/gallon}$$

**Q54. Convert a speed of 72 km/h into m/s.**

**Answer:** 20 m/s

**Solution:**

$$1 \text{ km} = 1000 \text{ m}, 1 \text{ hour} = 3600 \text{ s}$$

$$\text{Speed} = 72 \times (1000 \div 3600) = 72 \times (5/18) = 20 \text{ m/s}$$

**Q55. A cylindrical tank has a volume of 1.2 m<sup>3</sup>. Convert this volume into litres.**

**Answer:** 1200 litres

**Solution:**

$$1 \text{ m}^3 = 1000 \text{ litres}$$

$$\text{Volume} = 1.2 \times 1000 = 1200 \text{ litres}$$

**Q56. The density of a metal is 7.8 g/cm<sup>3</sup> and its volume is 250 cm<sup>3</sup>. Calculate its mass.**

**Answer:** 1950 g

**Solution:**

$$\text{Mass} = \text{Density} \times \text{Volume}$$

$$\text{Mass} = 7.8 \text{ g/cm}^3 \times 250 \text{ cm}^3 = 1950 \text{ g}$$

**Q57. A block has a mass of 2.5 kg and a volume of 0.0005 m<sup>3</sup>. Find the density in kg/m<sup>3</sup>.**

**Answer:** 5000 kg/m<sup>3</sup>

**Solution:**

$$\text{Density} = \text{Mass} \div \text{Volume}$$

$$\text{Density} = 2.5 \text{ kg} \div 0.0005 \text{ m}^3 = 5000 \text{ kg/m}^3$$

**Q58. The pressure exerted by a force of 300 N on a surface is 50 N/m<sup>2</sup>. Calculate the area of the surface.**

**Answer:** 6 m<sup>2</sup>

**Solution:**

$$\text{Pressure} = \text{Force} \div \text{Area}$$



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Area = Force ÷ Pressure

$$\text{Area} = 300 \text{ N} \div 50 \text{ N/m}^2 = 6 \text{ m}^2$$

**Q59. If 5 workers can complete a task in 12 days, how long would 8 workers take, working at the same rate?**

**Answer:** 7.5 days

**Solution:**

$$\text{Work} = \text{Workers} \times \text{Days} = 5 \times 12 = 60 \text{ worker-days}$$

$$\text{Days} = \text{Work} \div \text{Workers} = 60 \div 8 = 7.5 \text{ days}$$

**Q60. A recipe that serves 8 uses 240 g of sugar. How much sugar is needed for a recipe that serves 5?**

**Answer:** 150 g

**Solution:**

$$\text{Sugar per serving} = 240 \text{ g} \div 8 = 30 \text{ g}$$

$$\text{For 5 servings} = 30 \text{ g} \times 5 = 150 \text{ g}$$

**Q61. The cost of 7 kg of rice is £19.25. What is the cost of 3.5 kg of rice?**

**Answer:** £9.63

**Solution:**

$$\text{Cost per kg} = £19.25 \div 7 = £2.75$$

$$\text{Cost of 3.5 kg} = 3.5 \times £2.75 = £9.625 \approx £9.63$$

**Q62. A car travels 40 km in 32 minutes. Calculate its speed in km/h.**

**Answer:** 75 km/h

**Solution:**

$$\text{Time in hours} = 32 \div 60 = 0.533... \text{ hours}$$

$$\text{Speed} = \text{Distance} \div \text{Time}$$

$$\text{Speed} = 40 \div 0.533... = 75 \text{ km/h}$$

**Q63. A car moves with constant acceleration and its speed increases from 20 m/s to 40 m/s in 5 seconds. Find the acceleration.**

**Answer:** 4 m/s<sup>2</sup>

**Solution:**

$$\text{Acceleration} = (\text{Final speed} - \text{Initial speed}) \div \text{Time}$$

$$\text{Acceleration} = (40 - 20) \div 5 = 20 \div 5 = 4 \text{ m/s}^2$$

**Q64. Divide £84 between A and B in the ratio 5:7.**

**Answer:** A gets £35, B gets £49

**Solution:**

$$\text{Total parts} = 5 + 7 = 12$$

$$\text{A's share} = (5/12) \times 84 = £35$$

$$\text{B's share} = (7/12) \times 84 = £49$$



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**Q65. Divide 270 ml of a solution into two parts in the ratio 2:7.**

**Answer:** 60 ml and 210 ml

**Solution:**

$$\text{Total parts} = 2 + 7 = 9$$

$$\text{First part} = (2/9) \times 270 = 60 \text{ ml}$$

$$\text{Second part} = (7/9) \times 270 = 210 \text{ ml}$$

**Q66. Express 4:11 as a part : whole ratio.**

**Answer:** 4:15

**Solution:**

$$\text{Whole} = 4 + 11 = 15$$

$$\text{Part : Whole} = 4:15$$

**Q67. Express the division of 80 items into two parts as a ratio, where one part is 20 and the other is 60.**

**Answer:** 1:3

**Solution:**

$$20:60 = 1:3 \text{ (Divide both parts by 20)}$$

**Q68. In a mixture of juice and water in the ratio 3:2, how much juice is there if the total mixture is 1.25 litres?**

**Answer:** 0.75 litres

**Solution:**

$$\text{Total parts} = 3 + 2 = 5$$

$$\text{Juice} = (3/5) \times 1.25 = 0.75 \text{ litres}$$

**Q69. In a class of 40 students, the ratio of girls to boys is 3:5. How many girls are there?**

**Answer:** 15 girls

**Solution:**

$$\text{Total parts} = 3 + 5 = 8$$

$$\text{Girls} = (3/8) \times 40 = 15$$

**Q70. A map has a scale of 1:25,000. What is the actual distance in kilometres if the map distance is 8 cm?**

**Answer:** 2 km

**Solution:**

$$\text{Actual distance} = 8 \times 25,000 = 200,000 \text{ cm}$$

$$\text{Convert to km: } 200,000 \div 100,000 = 2 \text{ km}$$

**Q71. A model car is built to a scale of 1:20. If the actual car is 4.2 m long, what is the length of the model in cm?**

**Answer:** 21 cm

**Solution:**



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Actual length = 4.2 m = 420 cm

Model length =  $420 \div 20 = 21$  cm

**Q72. A rectangle is enlarged by a scale factor of 1.5. Its original area is 48 cm<sup>2</sup>. What is the area of the enlarged rectangle?**

**Answer:** 108 cm<sup>2</sup>

**Solution:**

Area scale factor = (Linear scale factor)<sup>2</sup> =  $(1.5)^2 = 2.25$

New area =  $48 \times 2.25 = 108$  cm<sup>2</sup>

**Q73. A cube has a surface area of 150 cm<sup>2</sup>. It is scaled by a factor of 2. What is the surface area of the scaled cube?**

**Answer:** 600 cm<sup>2</sup>

**Solution:**

Surface area scale factor = (Scale factor)<sup>2</sup> =  $(2)^2 = 4$

New surface area =  $150 \times 4 = 600$  cm<sup>2</sup>

**Q74. A jug contains a drink made by mixing orange juice and water in a 5:3 ratio. If there is 2 litres of water, how much orange juice is needed?**

**Answer:** 3.33 litres

**Solution:**

5 parts orange juice : 3 parts water

If 3 parts = 2 litres, then 1 part =  $2 \div 3 = 0.666\dots$  litres

Orange juice =  $5 \times 0.666\dots = 3.33$  litres

**Q75. A car was purchased for £8,000. Its value depreciates by 15% per year. What is its value after one year?**

**Answer:** £6800

**Solution:**

Depreciation = 15% of 8000 =  $0.15 \times 8000 = £1200$

New value =  $8000 - 1200 = £6800$

**Q76. A population of 5000 increases by 4% per year. What will the population be after one year?**

**Answer:** 5200

**Solution:**

Increase = 4% of 5000 =  $0.04 \times 5000 = 200$

New population =  $5000 + 200 = 5200$

**Q77. A bank offers compound interest at 3% annually. How much will £2000 grow to after one year?**

**Answer:** £2060

**Solution:**



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Growth = 3% of 2000 =  $0.03 \times 2000 = \text{£}60$

Total =  $2000 + 60 = \text{£}2060$

**Q78. A value grows from 150 to 180. Calculate the percentage increase.**

**Answer:** 20%

**Solution:**

Increase =  $180 - 150 = 30$

**Solution:**

$$\begin{aligned} X &\propto 1/Y \Rightarrow X = k/Y \\ 6 &= k/2 \Rightarrow k = 12 \\ X &= 12/8 \\ X &= 1.5 \end{aligned}$$

**Q238. A straight line goes through (0, 2) and (3, 11). Find its gradient.**

**Answer:** 3

**Solution:**

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Gradient} &= (\text{Change in } y) \div (\text{Change in } x) \\ &= (11 - 2) \div (3 - 0) \\ &= 9 \div 3 \\ &= 3 \end{aligned}$$

**Q239. Find the gradient of the curve  $y = x^2$  at  $x = 3$  using the tangent method.**

**Answer:** 6 (approx.)

**Solution:**

$$\begin{aligned} &\text{Draw a tangent at point } (3, 9) \\ &\text{Choose two points on the tangent, e.g. } (2, 3) \text{ and } (4, 15) \\ \text{Gradient} &= (15 - 3) \div (4 - 2) \\ &= 12 \div 2 \\ &= 6 \end{aligned}$$

**Q240. Explain how the gradient of a chord estimates the average rate of change between two points.**

**Answer:** It shows the average rate of change of  $y$  with respect to  $x$

**Solution:**

Gradient of a chord = (Change in  $y$ )  $\div$  (Change in  $x$ )

It connects two points and gives an average rate of change over the interval

**Q241. A car's speed increases from 30 mph to 50 mph in 10 seconds. Find the average acceleration.**

**Answer:**  $0.89 \text{ m/s}^2$

**Solution:**

Convert mph to m/s:

30 mph  $\approx$  13.41 m/s

50 mph  $\approx$  22.35 m/s

Acceleration = (Final speed - Initial speed)  $\div$  Time

= (22.35 - 13.41)  $\div$  10

= 8.94  $\div$  10

=  $0.894 \text{ m/s}^2 \approx 0.89 \text{ m/s}^2$

**Q242. A rectangular tank holds 6000 litres of water and is 2 metres long and 1.5 metres wide. Find its height in metres.**

**Answer:** 2 m

**Solution:**

6000 litres =  $6 \text{ m}^3$

Volume = length  $\times$  width  $\times$  height

$6 = 2 \times 1.5 \times \text{height}$

$6 = 3 \times \text{height}$

height =  $6 \div 3$

height = 2 m

**Q243. A person earns £2500 per month. What is their annual income?**

**Answer:** £30,000

**Solution:**

Annual income = Monthly income  $\times$  12

=  $2500 \times 12$

= £30,000

**Q244. A builder is paid £150 for 8 hours of work. What is the rate of pay per hour?**

**Answer:** £18.75 per hour

**Solution:**

Rate = Total pay  $\div$  Hours

=  $150 \div 8$

= £18.75

**Q245. A triangle has sides 5 cm, 12 cm and 13 cm. Show it is a right-angled triangle.**

**Answer:** Yes, it is a right-angled triangle

**Solution:**

Check Pythagoras:

$$5^2 + 12^2 = 25 + 144 = 169$$

$$13^2 = 169$$

Since  $5^2 + 12^2 = 13^2$ , it is right-angled

**Q246. Use trigonometry to find the angle in a triangle where the opposite side is 7 cm and the hypotenuse is 14 cm.**

**Answer:**  $30^\circ$

**Solution:**

$\sin(\theta) = \text{opposite} \div \text{hypotenuse}$

$$\sin(\theta) = 7 \div 14$$

$$\sin(\theta) = 0.5$$

$$\theta = \sin^{-1}(0.5)$$

$$\theta = 30^\circ$$

**Q247. Sketch a graph of a function showing inverse proportion.**

**Answer:** A decreasing curve from top left to bottom right

**Solution:**

The graph of  $y = k/x$  is an inverse proportion

It curves downward and never touches the axes

**Q248. Sketch a graph of  $y = 3x$  and describe its gradient.**

**Answer:** A straight line with gradient 3

**Solution:**

The line goes through the origin and rises steeply

Gradient = 3 means for every 1 unit increase in  $x$ ,  $y$  increases by 3

**Q249. Use a tangent to estimate the rate of change at  $x = 2$  for  $y = x^3$ .**

**Answer:** 12

**Solution:**

$$y = x^3 \Rightarrow \text{at } x = 2, y = 8$$

Tangent at  $x = 2$  has a gradient of  $dy/dx = 3x^2$

$$\text{At } x = 2, dy/dx = 3(2)^2 = 3 \times 4 = 12$$

So, rate of change = 12

**Q250. A value triples every 5 years. If the current value is £200, what will it be in 10 years?**

**Answer:** £1800

**Solution:**

$$\text{Value after 5 years} = 200 \times 3 = 600$$

$$\text{Value after 10 years} = 600 \times 3 = 1800$$

Or directly:

$$\text{Value} = 200 \times 3^2 = 200 \times 9 = \text{£}1800$$

**Q251. A car loses 15% of its value each year. If it's worth £12,000 now, estimate its value in 3 years.**

**Answer:** £7,377

**Solution:**

$$\text{Value after 1 year} = 12000 \times 0.85 = 10200$$

$$\text{Value after 2 years} = 10200 \times 0.85 = 8670$$

$$\text{Value after 3 years} = 8670 \times 0.85 = 7377$$

**Q252. A house value increases by 2% per month. If it is worth £150,000 now, what is it worth in 6 months?**

**Answer:** £159,327.63

**Solution:**

$$\text{Value} = 150000 \times (1.02)^6$$

$$= 150000 \times 1.126162$$

$$\approx \text{£}159,327.63$$

**Q253. Find the unit cost of 7 pencils costing £3.15.**

**Answer:** £0.45

**Solution:**

$$\text{Unit cost} = 3.15 \div 7$$

$$= \text{£}0.45$$

**Q254. Find the density of an object with mass 5.2 kg and volume 2.5 m<sup>3</sup>.**

**Answer:** 2.08 kg/m<sup>3</sup>

**Solution:**

$$\text{Density} = \text{Mass} \div \text{Volume}$$

$$= 5.2 \div 2.5$$

$$= 2.08 \text{ kg/m}^3$$

**Q255. Explain how pressure changes when force increases but area remains constant.**

**Answer:** Pressure increases

**Solution:**

$$\text{Pressure} = \text{Force} \div \text{Area}$$

If area is constant and force increases, pressure increases proportionally

**Q256. A population of 8000 increases at a rate of 1.5% per year. How many people after 2 years?**

**Answer:** 8242

Population after 1 year =  $8000 \times 1.015 = 8120$

Population after 2 years =  $8120 \times 1.015 = 8242$

**Q257. An investment grows from £2000 to £2200 in 2 years. Find the annual percentage growth rate.**

**Answer:** 4.88%

**Solution:**

$$2200 = 2000 \times (1 + r)^2$$

$$1.1 = (1 + r)^2$$

$$\sqrt{1.1} = 1 + r$$

$$1.0488 = 1 + r$$

$$r = 0.0488 = 4.88\%$$

**Q258. A length of 4.5 m is increased by 60%. Find the new length.**

**Answer:** 7.2 m

**Solution:**

$$\text{Increase} = 4.5 \times 0.6 = 2.7$$

$$\text{New length} = 4.5 + 2.7 = 7.2 \text{ m}$$

**Q259. A company makes 5 widgets in 2 hours. How many widgets in 10 hours?**

**Answer:** 25 widgets

**Solution:**

$$\text{Widgets per hour} = 5 \div 2 = 2.5$$

$$\text{Widgets in 10 hours} = 2.5 \times 10 = 25$$

**Q260. A straight line passes through (1, 2) and (4, 8). Find its gradient.**

**Answer:** 2

**Solution:**

$$\text{Gradient} = (8 - 2) \div (4 - 1)$$

$$= 6 \div 3$$

$$= 2$$

**Q261. Use iteration to solve  $x = (6 + x)/2$ , starting with  $x = 1$ .**

**Answer:** Step 1: 3.5, Step 2: 4.75, Step 3: 5.375

**Solution:**

$$x_1 = (6 + 1)/2 = 7/2 = 3.5$$

$$x_2 = (6 + 3.5)/2 = 9.5/2 = 4.75$$

$$x_3 = (6 + 4.75)/2 = 10.75/2 = 5.375$$

**Q262. In a right-angled triangle,  $\sin \theta = 0.6$ . Find  $\theta$ .**

**Answer:**  $36.87^\circ$

**Solution:**

$$\theta = \sin^{-1}(0.6)$$

$$\theta \approx 36.87^\circ$$

**Q263. A line has gradient 4. What is the change in y when x increases by 3?**

**Answer:** 12

**Solution:**

$$\text{Change in } y = \text{Gradient} \times \text{Change in } x$$

$$= 4 \times 3$$

$$= 12$$

**Q264. If area is proportional to the square of the scale factor, what happens to the area if the scale factor is doubled?**

**Answer:** Area becomes 4 times greater

**Solution:**

$$\text{New area} = \text{Original area} \times (2^2)$$

$$= 4 \times \text{Original area}$$

**Q265. Two cones are similar. Their heights are in the ratio 3:5. Find the ratio of their volumes.**

**Answer:** 27:125

**Solution:**

$$\text{Volume ratio} = (\text{Height ratio})^3$$

$$= (3:5)^3$$

$$= 27:125$$

**Q266. A truck travels 250 km in 3.5 hours. Find the speed in km/h.**

**Answer:** 71.43 km/h

**Solution:**

$$\text{Speed} = \text{Distance} \div \text{Time}$$

$$= 250 \div 3.5$$

$$= 71.43 \text{ km/h}$$

**Q267. An object is 2.5 m tall in real life and 5 cm tall in a model. Find the scale factor.**

**Answer:** 1:50

**Solution:**

$$\text{Convert } 2.5 \text{ m} = 250 \text{ cm}$$

$$\text{Scale} = 5:250 = 1:50$$

**Q268. A ball bounces to 80% of its previous height each time. If the first bounce is 2 m, how high is the third?**

**Answer:** 1.28 m

**Solution:**

$$\text{Second bounce} = 2 \times 0.8 = 1.6$$

$$\text{Third bounce} = 1.6 \times 0.8 = 1.28 \text{ m}$$

**Q269. A salary increases by 3% each year. How many years until it grows by at least 10%?**

**Answer:** 4 years

**Solution:**

Use growth formula:

$$\text{Final} = \text{Initial} \times (1.03)^n \geq 1.10 \times \text{Initial}$$

$$(1.03)^n \geq 1.10$$

$$n \approx \log(1.10) \div \log(1.03) \approx 0.0414 \div 0.0128 \approx 3.23$$

So, after 4 years

**Q270. Estimate the gradient of  $y = x^2 + 1$  at  $x = 2$  using a tangent.**

**Answer:** 4

**Solution:**

$$y = x^2 + 1$$

$$\text{At } x = 2, y = 4 + 1 = 5$$

$$\text{Tangent gradient} \approx \text{derivative} = dy/dx = 2x$$

$$\text{At } x = 2, dy/dx = 2 \times 2 = 4$$

**Q271. A graph shows speed-time. What does the gradient represent?**

**Answer:** Acceleration

**Solution:**

$$\text{Gradient} = \text{Change in speed} \div \text{Time}$$

So, gradient of speed-time graph is acceleration

**Q272. A boat travels 240 km in 5 hours. Find the average speed.**

**Answer:** 48 km/h

**Solution:**

$$\text{Speed} = \text{Distance} \div \text{Time}$$

$$= 240 \div 5$$

$$= 48 \text{ km/h}$$

**Q273. A model is made with scale 1:100. What is the real length if the model is 7 cm?**

**Answer:** 700 cm

**Solution:**

$$\text{Real length} = \text{Model length} \times \text{Scale}$$

$$= 7 \times 100$$

$$= 700 \text{ cm}$$

**Q274. An object loses half its value every year. If it's worth £400 now, what will it be worth in 3 years?**

**Answer:** £50

**Solution:**

$$\text{After 1 year} = 400 \times 0.5 = 200$$

After 2 years =  $200 \times 0.5 = 100$

After 3 years =  $100 \times 0.5 = 50$

**Q275. A tank fills at a constant rate. After 4 minutes, it contains 80 litres. How much in 7 minutes?**

**Answer:** 140 litres

**Solution:**

Rate =  $80 \div 4 = 20$  litres/min

In 7 minutes =  $20 \times 7 = 140$  litres

**Q276. The side of a square increases by 50%. Find the percentage increase in area.**

**Answer:** 125%

**Solution:**

Let side = 1, area =  $1^2 = 1$

New side = 1.5, area =  $1.5^2 = 2.25$

Increase =  $2.25 - 1 = 1.25$

Percentage increase =  $(1.25 \div 1) \times 100 = 125\%$

**Q277. Water flows at 6 litres per minute. How much flows in 45 minutes?**

**Answer:** 270 litres

**Solution:**

Flow = Rate  $\times$  Time

=  $6 \times 45$

= 270 litres

**Q278. A graph shows the curve  $y = \sqrt{x}$ . Estimate the gradient at  $x = 4$ .**

**Answer:** 0.25

**Solution:**

$y = \sqrt{x}$

$dy/dx = 1 \div (2\sqrt{x})$

At  $x = 4$ ,  $dy/dx = 1 \div (2 \times 2) = 1 \div 4 = 0.25$

**Q279. X and Y are inversely proportional. If X = 6 and Y = 2, find Y when X = 3.**

**Answer:** 4

**Solution:**

$XY = k$

$6 \times 2 = 12$

When  $X = 3$ ,  $3 \times Y = 12$

$Y = 12 \div 3 = 4$



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Q280. A straight line has the equation  $y = 4x - 1$ . What is the rate of change of  $y$  with respect to  $x$ ?

**Answer:** 4

**Solution:**

Rate of change = Gradient

From  $y = mx + c$ ,  $m = 4$

So, rate of change = 4

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
